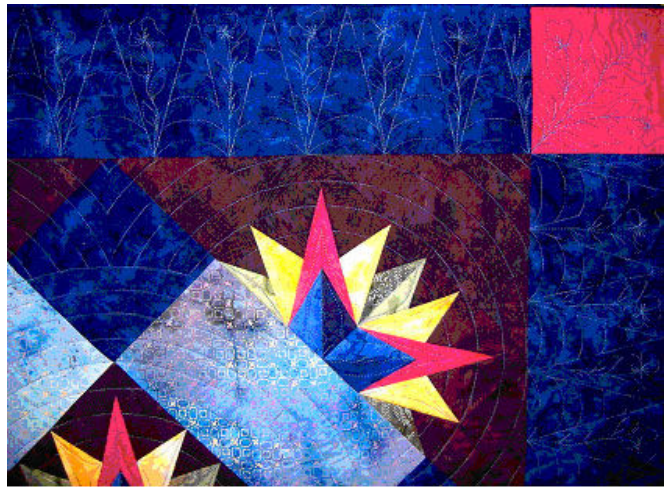

PAPER PIECING PERFECTION AND LOVING IT!

Whether you are new to paper piecing or have some experience, this class will bring you to a new level. Working from Carol's book, *Mariner's Compass Stars*, learn about choosing fabrics, organizing a cutting list and cutting fabrics quickly and efficiently. Add skills of paper-piecing. Assembly-line fashion, joining blocks perfectly and simply enjoying the process of creating perfect blocks. Also covered: creative quick-setting options and statement making quilting ideas.

I am delighted you will be joining me for a wonderful week. We will use the Royal Radiance Quilt to learn the entire process of choosing your fabrics, cutting them efficiently, organizing your sewing and completing your quilt top. Although we are using this quilt to learn the process, throughout the week, I will share lots of tidbits of information to add to your enjoyment of foundation paper piecing. **Example: Royal Radiance Quilt from Simply Sensational 9-Patch Stars-finished size 46" X 46"**

Fabric:

Using the above photos as a guide, **bring a minimum of:**

- 1). 8 (eight) different fabrics, 1 1/2 yards each. Choose at least **one very dark or very light non-directional fabric for the background area** of the blocks (where I used the burgundy) and the remaining **7 fabrics to be used either as rays or setting pieces** (these pieces can be directional).
- 2). 1 1/2 yards is the most you will need for the area where I used the dark blue in the above photos. You are welcome to bring extra fabrics if you would like to. As part of the learning experience, in class you will audition your fabrics and decide which fabric to use in which position.

If you anticipate quilting your quilt while there, I have listed the backing and batting measurements.

- 3). Backing: 2 7/8 yards
- 4). Batting: 50" x 50"

Tools:

- 1). Sewing machine (If you have a knee lift, bring it), open-toe presser foot
- 2). Needles size 90/14,
- 3). Thread to match fabric.
- 4). Rotary cutter, and large rotary mat.
- 5). 6" x 12" and 6" x 24" rotary rulers, 12" Add-A-Quarter ruler
- 6). Flat-headed pins
- 7). Scissors or snips
- 8). Rotary Point cutter for taking out those oops...
- 9). Curved pointed snips for cutting your threads quickly
- 10). Stick-on note pads and pencil.
- 11). Scotch™ Removable tape for repairing your foundations if needed
- 12). Your camera to record the fun!
- 13). **Carol will be supplying your foundations.**

Note: Carol will have available for purchase a selection of her paper piecing books, the 12" Add-A-Quarter ruler, the curved pointed snips and rotary point cutter.
